CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The Special Meeting of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Kyle Jones at 7:01 p.m. on Monday, May 6, 2019.

BUSINESS PRIOR TO PUBLIC INPUT

A public hearing on annexation of parcels #05-05-18-400-015, #05-05-18-300-002, and #05-05-18-400-011 was opened at 7:02 p.m. Mr. Brimm stated that the first two parcels from the Jeanette Kunz trust encompass approximately 151.69 acres of undeveloped farmland. Per city ordinance the property will be zoned SR-1 upon annexation with the intent to change that to either highway business or industrial depending upon development. The next parcel is from the William Kunz trust and encompasses approximately 18.3 of undeveloped farmland. Again this parcel will annex in as SR-1 with the intent to change zoning to either B-3 highway business or I-1 industrial with interest from a developer. All of these properties are slated to be included in the North Trenton Redevelopment District and the North Trenton Business District. There were no questions from the Council or the public.

Motion Alderman Woods, second Alderman Hooker to adjourn the public hearing. All yes, motion carried. The hearing adjourned at 7:05 p.m.

Alderman Hooker made a motion to Approve Ordinance #1745 Annexing Certain Property to the City of Trenton, Clinton County, Illinois, Being Parcel Numbers 05-05-18-400-015, 05-05-18-300-002, and 05-05-18-400-011. Second Alderman Weh, all yes. Motion carried.
