

City of Trenton Waste Disposal Services

Republic Services provides **weekly** collection of regular household trash and provides an **every-other-week** collection of recycle materials. The city of Trenton will bill you for these services. Republic Services provides a cart for trash and a cart for recycle materials; therefore, personal containers are prohibited. Trash and recycle material must be contained inside the carts. Please contact Republic Services if you would like to lease any additional trash or recycle carts. Reminder, trash and recycle materials cannot be mixed together. **Please have carts to curb on service day by 6 a.m.**

Republic Services also provides weekly collection of yard waste. You may use your own cans, not to exceed 32-gallon size, marked with a red "X", or paper yard waste bags found at most grocery and hardware stores. Yard Waste includes leaves, grass, and shrub/flower/tree trimmings. Sticks and twigs up to 4 inches in diameter will be collected but must be gathered into 2'x4' bundles tied with twine. There is a 50-pound weight limit per can or bag.

Republic Services recognizes six holidays; New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. PLEASE NOTE: No pick-up on these holidays. Should your pick-up day fall on or after the holiday, your trash, recycle and yard waste will be collected one day late.

Republic Services provides a large item and white good (appliance) pick-up for residents four times per calendar year. Please call Republic Services at (618) 656-6883 when you are ready to schedule your large item pick up. Large items include furniture, mattress sets and large carpets (cut into manageable bundles no longer than 4ft. and weighing no more than 50lbs each.) Glass portions of doors, windows, etc. should be broken and placed into a small box marked "glass." Electronic waste (including televisions) as well as concrete, shingles, construction debris/home remodeling construction debris of any kind, tires, yard waste (including tree stumps) and railroad ties are prohibited. Loose materials or materials in cardboard boxes will not be serviced, as all items must be bagged and contained.

TRASH is collected every MONDAY YARD WASTE is collected every WEDNESDAY RECYCLE is collected every other FRIDAY

PROPER CONTAINER PLACEMENT

- Have the container at the curb by 6:00 a.m. of your collection day. Carts placed in alleys will not be serviced.
- Place the container at least five feet from any object; like a tree, pole, fire hydrant, mailbox, electrical box, cable box, etc. and at least five feet away from cars so the automated arm can reach your container.
- Please have the same distance of five feet between waste and recycle containers.
- · Don't lean anything against the container.
- Don't place your container under a tree or near utility lines.

Proper Cart Placement is the Key to Automated Service



- Place containers one foot from the curb or edge of the street.
- Remember to place the arrows on the lid of the container toward the street and the handle toward your house, with the lid closed.
